- Minera Community Council (MCC) met on 15<sup>th</sup> March. The meeting covered outstanding general and project business. Dates and agendas for all meetings are published in advance on the website.
- The “formal” opening of the Gwynfryn playground will be on April 21<sup>st</sup>. at 2pm. Mrs Pat Edwards has kindly agreed to perform the ceremony. The community council will install a bench at the playground, and a plaque in memory of Cllr John Edwards.
- At the community council meeting, it was agreed that the community council will continue to fund the Youth Service in Minera in the next financial year. Numbers attending at the restored container at the football field continue to grow and it is a valuable resource for the young people in our community.
- Public computers at Coedpoeth library in Plas Pentwyn are back, and are available for use.
- The defibrillator has been installed in the renovated kiosk in New Brighton, and is available for use in an emergency. The next cabinet for the community has arrived and will be placed at the Lead Mines. The community council has funded training at the beginning of April for anyone interested in emergency first aid, and use of the debibrillator
- Councillors noted with appreciation the promptness with which North Wales Police had responded to a recent incident of burglary and vandalism in Gwynfryn
- North Wales Wildlife Trust had dealt with two dangerous trees promptly following reports that they had become hazardous. Recent snowfall had also brought down a number of branches as well as entire young trees, with much of the debris already dealt with. Some fence damage remained, however.
- Maintenance by the wildlife Trust along the old Berwig line is continuing.
- Councillors discussed how to mark the forthcoming coronation of the King within the community. The clerk will liaise with Minera School, and the Community Agent so that any actions by the community council benefit the older and younger members of our community
